# THE PARKS AT UCDAVIS SUBLEASE ELIGIBILITY STATEMENT

## PLANNING TO SUBLET YOUR APARTMENT?

Orchard Park and Solano Park leaseholders wishing to sublet their apartments may do so for one quarter/semester or during summer, provided they will be registered for the upcoming regular academic quarter/semester. The lease is unassignable either in whole or in part and the right of occupancy may not be granted to any other occupants without prior written consent from the University. In addition, your apartment may be sublet only to registered students, faculty, or staff of UC Davis.

Please read these important instructions before submitting <u>Sublease Eligibility Statement</u>:

- Complete the attached <u>Sublease Eligibility Statement</u> which must be signed by both you and your prospective sublesee.
- Return the completed form to:

- The <u>Sublease Eligibility Statement</u> must be approved by Residential Services before any agreement can be finalized.
- The leaseholder, not the sublesee, is responsible for ensuring that the monthly rent is paid on time. Any late fees will be assessed to the leaseholder.
- The leaseholder may not sublease the apartment to a current occupant listed on the lease agreement (i.e. spouse, roommate, partner). The leaseholder may not remove an occupant from their lease in order to sublease to that occupant.
  - Additional occupants residing with the sublesee must be related to the sublesee.
- If the leaseholder has an additional adult residing in the unit, they must leave during the sublease period.
- The leaseholder is responsible for any damages to the apartment caused by the sublesee while the apartment is being sublet. Any damage charges are the responsibility of the leaseholder.
  - a. Leaseholder parking permits cannot be used on the sublesee's vehicle.
  - b. If the leaseholder does not have a vehicle and the sublease is bringing a vehicle during the sublease period, the leaseholder must purchase a temporary permit at the O1/S1 rate for the duration of the sublease period.
  - c. If the leaseholder is not planning to take their vehicle with them while the apartment is being sublet, the leaseholder must purchase a temporary permit for the sublesee's vehicle.
  - d. If the leaseholder will be taking his/her vehicle during the sublease period, the sublessee will given a temporary permit, free of charge that will allow them to park in an O1 or S1 space.
  - e. NOTE: all parking permits purchased at the Park Offices are charged to the leaseholder's student account.
- The sublesee is not authorized to request data port changes. It is the leaseholder's responsibility to inform the sublesee about this restriction.
- Key authorization for the sublesee must be submitted to the Park Office.
- The sublesee cannot use the leaseholder's mailbox to receive mail.
