DAY CAMP SESSION I, June 22 - 25 (Monday - Thursday)
DAY CAMP SESSION II, August 3 - 6 (Monday - Thursday)

At the Matt Matheny Basketball Camp, campers learn how to be well-rounded, team-oriented basketball players. The sessions offer intense, specialized basketball instruction with an emphasis on the fundamentals of basketball, including dribbling, shooting, rebounding and defense. The Matt Matheny Basketball Camp provides a rewarding and enjoyable experience for campers of all ability levels.

Our staff features Elon coaches, as well as experienced high school and college coaches from across the country. Camp activities include detailed fundamental instruction, as well as individual and team competition. All campers are grouped according to age and ability.

DAY CAMP

The Day Camp is open to boys, ages 7-18 (depending on the session), and focuses on teaching fundamental basketball skills and introducing basic game strategy. This is an outstanding camp for those just learning basketball or for those already playing on teams. Day camp hours are 9:00 am to 4:30 pm.

FACILITIES

The camp will be held at Alumni Gym located in the Koury Center. "All-you-can-eat" lunch will be served in Harden Dining Hall. The camp is privately run by Matt Matheny and his staff on the campus of Elon University.

DIRECTIONS

Take I-85/40 to Exit 140. From southbound 85/40, exit right and turn right. From northbound 85/40, exit right and turn left. Stay on University Drive for 1.4 miles and turn right on Highway 70 East/S. Church Street. Take Highway 70 East/S. Church Street to Williamson Avenue (.7 miles). Turn left on Williamson, continue on Williamson and the Koury Center is the first building on the right.

CAMP STORE & CAMP BANK

The camp store offers concessions and t-shirts. A camp bank will be available to safely keep spending money.

TRAINER

There is a qualified trainer on duty in case of illness or injury. The trainer will also administer prescribed medications if this service is requested at registration.

SCHEDULES

Daily and game schedules are posted in Alumni Gym. Game schedules are subject to change, especially on the last day of camp. Please check with your camper regarding game time if you plan to see him play on that day.

DAY CAMP TEAMS

Campers are placed on teams according to age, size and ability. Our priority in forming teams is to have balanced competition. Therefore, we do not honor team assignment requests. In some cases, players are "traded" from the team assigned at registration to better balance the competition.

Full tuition must be paid at time of registration. A refund (less a \$75 administrative fee) is available only if notification is received at least two weeks before camp begins. No refunds will be made within two weeks of camp beginning, except in case of serious injury. Documentation of the injury will be needed before the start of camp. There are a limited number of spaces available per session.

\$75 of the tuition payment is an administrative fee and is non-refundable. No Exceptions.
