Rules and Conditions

- 1) Royalty applicants must be students who have <u>completed</u> at least one quarter at EWU.
- Each sponsor may only enter one candidate for each category. The sponsoring Club or organization must be registered with the ASWEWU. One contestant may be sponsored by up to two organizations.
- 3) Each candidate must complete an official entry form.
- 4) All entries should be turned in to PUB 320 by noon, Oct. 15, 2009, or you may bring them to the candidate orientation, which will be held at 3 p.m., Thursday, Oct. 15, 2009. We will meet in the Pence Union Building, Room 261. This is not a closed orientation. If you would feel more comfortable bringing along a representative from your sponsoring group, a family member or a friend, feel free to do so.
- 5) Applicants must attend final rehearsal on Wednesday, Oct. 21, 2009 at 5 p.m., or make other arrangements with the Pageant Chairman.
- 6) Gender identity restrictions do not exist. However, each candidate must select one of the titles for which they are running either Mr. or Ms. Eastern.
- 7) Applicants should come prepared to have their pictures taken at the Oct. 15 orientation. (Business attire is required for photos.)
- 8) Contestants must provide their own personal props for the talent portion of the competition. A piano will be the only additional item available.
- 9) On Thursday, Oct. 22, the Royalty Pageant "*Eastern Elegance*" will be held at 7 p.m. Candidates must be dressed and at the designated location at 6pm. During the contest, a panel of judges will select Mr. and Ms. Eastern and two runners-up for each position. The finalists will be announced at the conclusion of the Pageant.
- 10) All Finalist MUST be present Friday, Oct. 23, for the Homecoming Parade and Saturday, Oct. 24 for the Homecoming Game. The Royalty Court will be presented at halftime of the game on Saturday.
- 11) The finalists are not just finalists, but also serve as Mr. and Ms. Eastern throughout the school year. Mr. and Ms. Eastern will be representatives for EWU engagements planned throughout the 2009-2010 school year. In event Mr. or Ms. Eastern cannot fulfill their duties, the court members will take their place.

12) EWU Royalty:
