

## **Need-based Scholarships for New Students**

Each year, the School of Professional Psychology at Forest Institute offers over \$150,000 in scholarships, fellowships and awards. Current and prospective students who wish to apply for these funds must first demonstrate financial need through eligibility for federal student aid. Forest receives notification of eligibility for federal aid one to two weeks after you complete the FAFSA. Filing the FAFSA does not automatically put you in consideration for these scholarships. Preference for scholarships will be given to students enrolling in the Dual/PsyD program, although master's applicants are also considered. Incoming students applying for the Spring (January) or Summer (June) semesters will be considered if funds remain available. **To apply, submit the completed Forest Scholarship Application and all other required materials to the Office of Admissions by the indicated deadline.**
