Scholarship recipients will be determined by the Deans of the Colleges at GSU, in consultation with division and program chairs as appropriate.

Scholarships will be renewable each term until the recipient has completed the four Certificate courses, subject to earning a B or better in each course attempted and continued approval by the Dean of the College for whom the recipient teaches.

Applicants are aware the Certificate in Online Teaching is a graduate-level program and, as such, will require 10-12 hours of time per week per course in order to successfully complete the required coursework.
