INSTRUCTIONS: High School students must present this form with all appropriate signatures, along with a photo identification card, when taking the P.E.R.T. at Indian River State College. High School students are not allowed to test without a referral form and a valid photo ID.

The P.E.R.T. is offered at a variety of times and takes approximately 3 hours to complete. NOTICE: As of February 12, 2012 High school students (public, private, and home-schooled) may only take each subtest of the P.E.R.T. two times during their high school career. High school students who have taken each subtest twice and have not yet achieved college-level placement scores will not be eligible to take the P.E.R.T. again until they graduate from high school and apply to college. Please note that this P.E.R.T. referral will count toward the high school testing limit.

Pursuant to State Rule 6A-10.0315, students who do not meet or exceed college-ready P.E.R.T. scores must complete postsecondary preparatory instruction prior to high school graduation. Students who complete the postsecondary preparatory instruction required in Section 1008.30(3), F.S., will have completed an alternative remediation opportunity. Completion of alternative remediation in high school does not satisfy the requirement for demonstrating college readiness or completing college preparatory instruction. A student will be required to retest after alternative remediation and meet or exceed college-ready placement scores to avoid required enrollment in college preparatory communication and computation instruction in accordance with this Rule.
