REGISTRATION

To reserve plane tickets and weekend accommodations, please submit your nonrefundable participation fee of \$300 payable to Johnson & Wales University. (The fee includes round trip airfare, meals and accommodations upon arrival.)

Please submit a separate nonrefundable registration fee of \$300 per person for up to three members of your immediate family who wish to accompany you during your visit. This fee will cover their airline ticket, accommodations and meals.

REGISTRATION

To reserve your spot in the program, please submit a nonrefundable payment of \$100, payable to Johnson & Wales University.

For up to three family members accompanying you on your visit, please submit a separate nonrefundable registration fee of \$100 per person for their accommodations and meals.*

TRAVEL & HOTEL ARRANGEMENTS

To make this an enjoyable learning experience, JWU is ready to assist with your arrangements. If you live more than a six-hour drive from your campus of choice, JWU will book your flights and hotel. If you live less than six hours away, JWU will book your hotel. Call the Admissions Events Office at the campus you plan to visit with questions about which program you are eligible to attend.

Please review all program dates and deadlines, choose your dates and campus, and fill out the registration form. Upon receipt of your registration, a confirmation letter will be mailed to you one week prior to your program of choice.

If you are flying, your electronic ticket confirmation and hotel confirmation will be mailed to you one week prior to your program of choice.

SUPERVISION

Students under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian unless a letter of permission is sent to, and approved by, the Admissions Events Office prior to arrival on campus.

RESERVATION DEADLINES

The university must receive your reservation form and payment no later than the deadline date for the WILDCAT WEEKEND you plan to attend. When payment is received, airfare will be booked by the university in accordance to the information provided on the registration form. Once purchased, tickets are nonrefundable and nontransferable. The participants are responsible for any costs incurred due to changes in flight arrangements once the tickets have been purchased.

PLEASE NOTE: The university reserves the right to cancel any program due to insufficient enrollment. In such cases, the full program fee is refundable. The university assumes no responsibility for any other expenses incurred due to cancellation of a program.
