Youth Camp—June 18-19 Time: 8:30 am—4 pm Ages: entering grades 1 thru 8

Campers will receive two days of expert and personal instruction. We will place an emphasis on fun and the enjoyment of playing football. Each session will focus on football skills and also on games and football related activities. The coaching and teaching sessions will be geared towards the basic fundamentals of football and allow each camper the opportunity to play and learn each offensive position, defensive position and special teams.

It is a perfect opportunity for coaches to bring their whole team for a day of instruction and competition. The camp will feature personalized instruction, an emphasis on specific

techniques, and the basic skills of line play. These sessions are designed to enhance and develop stance and starts, footwork, change of direction, hand placements, and proper pad level.
