The Game

The Liberty men's basketball team (14-7, 8-1 BSC) returns to the Vines Center on Thursday, playing host to UNC Asheville (10-9, 5-4 BSC) at 7 p.m. Currently in a three-way tie for third place in the conference standings, the Bulldogs are looking to gain ground on the second-place Flames, who are off to an unprecedented start through the first half of conference play.

Liberty will attempt to complete a sweep of the Bulldogs for the first time since the 2004-05 campaign, after edging UNC Asheville on Jan. 2 in the Justice Center, 59-55. The outcome could also mark a milestone for head coach Dale Layer, as he goes for his 300th career win.

Recent Results

The Liberty men's basketball team continued its stellar run in conference play, last Thursday night, defeating the VMI Keydets, 100-82.

Liberty's victory over the country's No. 1 scoring offense markedthe first time the team has reached triple digits in scoring since Jan. 2, 2009, when the Flames bested the Keydets in Cameron Hall, 110-102.

Led by David Minaya's career-high 22 points, Liberty moved to 14-7 overall and an 8-1 in the Big South through the first half of the conference season. Despite a 29-point effort by Austin Kenon, VMI fell to 11-8 on the season and 4-5 in conference play. The Keydet defeat also halted a four-game win streak in Big South road games.

Watch and listen to the Flames

Thursday's contest will be televised on the Flames Sports Network, MASN, ESPN Full-Court and ESPN3.com, with Ray Jones providing the play-by-play and Tim Scarbrough adding color commentary.

There will be a Flames Sports Network radio broadcast (flagship WRVL 88.3 FM) with Alan York providing the play-by-play. York took over play-by-play duties this season for longtime broadcaster Jerry Edwards, who retired this past spring after 29 years.

In addition to the radio broadcast, an Internet audio broadcast on LibertyFlames.com will be available. There will also be a live video stream of the broadcast via the Big South Network, available on BigSouthSports.com.

Currently in his second season as head coach of the Flames, Dale Layer is the eighth coach in program history. Layer returned to Liberty Mountain in 2009 after previously serving as an assistant coach for the Flames during the 2007-08 season.

This is Layer's third head coaching stint and first since leaving Colorado State in 2007. Layer, 51, comes to Liberty most recently from a successful run as an assistant coach at BIG EAST member and nationally ranked Marquette in 2008-09 where he worked with the guards. Layer helped the Eagles to a 25-10 record and a second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament despite lacking the full-time services of All-American Dominic James, who injured himself near the end of the season.

Dale Layer first served as an assistant at Liberty during the 2007-08 season, helping the Flames to its best regular season finish since Liberty won the 2004 Big South Championship.

Layer has also demonstrated the ability to develop talent, including former Colorado State center Jason Smith. The seven-footer scored over 1,500 points for Layer's Rams during his three seasons with the program before entering the NBA Draft following his junior campaign. Due to his development under Layer's tutelage, Smith was chosen with the 20th selection of the NBA Draft's first round by the Miami Heat in 2007. His rights were traded to the Philadelphia 76ers. When Smith graduated high school he was ranked as the 276th best player in his class and under Layer developed in three seasons to the 20th selection in the NBA Draft. Several of Layer's recruiting classes at Colorado State were ranked among the top 40 nationally by various recruiting publications.

Layer has a career 299-216 record (18th year) as a head coach, including nine seasons at the helm of Queens University (formally Queens College) in Charlotte, N.C. He also served as the athletics director while at the school and started the basketball program in 1989 from scratch at the formerly all women's institution. Layer's student-athletes excel in the classroom too. In Layer's 17 seasons as a head coach, he has accompanied 45 seniors to be honored on senior night and all 43 earned a college degree, marking 100 percent graduation rate of all players who finish their eligibility under Layer.

After graduating from Eckerd College in St. Petersburg, Fla., in 1980, Layer started his coaching career as an assistant under Jim Harley, his former coach. Before moving on to Queens University, Layer spent seven of the next eight years at Eckerd College except for the 1982-83 season, when he was an assistant at Eastern Kentucky.

Layer made the jump to Division I in 1998 when Ritchie McKay took the head coaching job at Colorado State and named him to his staff. During McKay's two seasons with the Rams, Layer helped lead Colorado State to the NIT Tournament in 1999, where they beat Mississippi State and Colorado before falling to eventual champion, California.

While with the Rams, Layer had a 103-106 record, including a 17-13 mark in 2007. In 2003, Layer led Colorado State to the Mountain West Conference Championship and its first NCAA Tournament bid in 13 years, falling to Duke in the first round.

Scouting the Bulldogs

UNC Asheville enters Thursday's contest with a 10-9 record overall and a 5-4 record in conference play. The Bulldogs are coming off a 77-69 win against Charleston Southern on Saturday. Five Bulldogs finished with double figures in scoring – Matt Dickey (14), Jaron Lane (13), J.P. Primm (11), Chris Stephenson (11) and Quinard Jackson (11). John Williams finished with a near double-double, posting nine points and nine rebounds.

Primm is seventh in the Big South in scoring and second in assists, averaging 15.6 points and 4.79 helpers per game. Cunningham is fourth in the league in rebounds with 8.3 boards per contest. Both players are also making an impact on the opposite end of the floor, as Cunningham leads the league in blocked shots (1.81 per game) and Primm is tied for second in steals (2.11 per game).

In addition to Primm and Cunningham, Dickey is third in the Big South in free throw percentage, shooting 82.0 percent from the charity stripe. Dickey is also sixth in steals with 1.74 per game.

Liberty-UNC Asheville Series Notes

Thursday's contest is the 47th meeting between the Flames and the Bulldogs. UNC Asheville holds the advantage in the series with a 27-19 record. With its 9-11 posting in the Vines Center, the Bulldogs have the second-best winning percentage among visiting conference teams in the facility (.450).

The series first began during Liberty's inaugural year in the Big South (1991-92). That season, the two teams clashed for the first time on Jan. 23, 1991, resulting in a 90-76 Flames win inside the Vines Center.

Last season, UNC Asheville claimed the first meeting with the Flames, leaving the Vines Center with a 74-70 victory on Jan. 16. Matt Dickey was the game's leading scorer, finishing with 22 points. Patrick Konan led the way in scoring for the Flames with 18 tallies. In the second meeting, UNC Asheville narrowly escaped the Flames once again, squeaking out a 75-72 victory inside the Justice Center on Feb. 11. Chris Stephenson paced the Bulldogs with 16 points. Evan Gordon led the Flames' in scoring with 16 tallies, followed by Kyle Ohman (15) and Jesse Sanders (15). Antwan Burrus recorded his third career double-double in the contest, posting 11 points and 10 boards.

Liberty bested the Bulldogs in the first meeting between the two squads this season, defeating UNC Asheville in the Justice Center, 59-55, on Jan. 2. The win not only kept the Flames unprecedented run intact, but marked the program's first win inside the Justice Center in nearly six years.

Prior to the tilt, the last time Liberty had tasted victory inside the facility was Feb. 24, 2005, when Larry Blair helped lead the Flames to a 92-80 win. Jesse Sanders and Evan Gordon paved the way for the Flames with 16 and 15 points, respectively, this time around.

Layer in the Big South

Liberty head coach Dale Layer holds a 22 -13 record against current members of the Big South. Layer is 3-0 against Charleston Southern, 0-3 against Coastal Carolina, 5-1 against Gardner-Webb, 2-1 against High Point, 3-0 against Presbyterian, 2-1 against Radford, 1-2 against UNC Asheville, 3-0 against VMI and 3-5 against Winthrop.

On Paper

Thursday's game pits the third-best scoring offense (UNC Asheville, 75.3 ppg) in the Big South against the second-best scoring defense (Liberty, 63.9 ppg). While the Flames are close to the top in scoring defense in the conference, the Bulldogs are near the bottom at eighth, allowing 71.1 points per game.

The Flames and Bulldogs are second and fourth in the Big South in rebounding, grabbing 39.7 and 38.0 boards each game, respectively. However, Liberty holds the advantage in rebound defense, allowing a league-leading 32.2 per contest. UNC Asheville is listed at eighth among Big South squads in the category, allowing 38.0 boards per game.

A Liberty Win ...

- Moves the team to 9-1 in conference play.
- Gives head Coach Dale Layer his 300th win. He is currently 299-216 for his career.
- Will mark the first sweep of the Bulldogs since the 2004-05 season. That year, Liberty edged the UNC Asheville in the Vines 72-71 (Jan. 22, 2005) and bested the Bulldogs in the Justice Center, 92-80 (Feb. 24, 2005).
- Would tie last season's win total of 15 victories.

Double Digit Quartet

Entering Thursday's contest, the Flames have four players averaging double figures in scoring – Evan Gordon (14.2), John Brown (11.6), David Minaya (10.3) and Jesse Sanders (10.2). The last time a Liberty squad had four players finish the season with double-digits in scoring was the 2006-07 season. The quartet consisted of Larry Blair (20.4), Dwight Brewington (14.7), Alex McLean (14.5) and Anthony Smith (11.4).

Sporting a 14-7 record, this season's team has the same number of overall and conference wins as the 2006-07 squad, which finished with a 14-17 record and an 8-6 posting in Big South action.

Brown Dish, Burrus Dunk Makes ESPN SportsCenter Top 10 Plays

Following Liberty's 100-82 victory over VMI, one particular play during the contest made the national highlight reel. Forward Antwan Burrus' two-handed slam in the latter portion of the second half was featured on the ESPN SportsCenter's Top 10 plays, tabbed No. 8 on the listing.

With less than 10 minutes remaining in the contest, David Minaya collected a rebound off a Stan Okoye miss and passed it to Jesse Sanders. The floor general lobbed it to John Brown, who while in midair, dished it to Burrus for the finish.

700 Club

Two Liberty players have the chance to reach 700 career points this week. Jesse Sanders is currently in 33rd place on Liberty's all-time scoring with 688 tallies. Meanwhile, Evan Gordon is following close behind in the 35th position with 670 points.

Home Sweet Home

With an 8-2 record at home this season, Liberty has a chance on Thursday to surpass its Vines Center win total from last season. During the 2009-10 campaign, the Flames garnered an 8-6 record in the facility.

Dimes and Boards

Jesse Sanders is one of two players in the country currently averaging at least six rebounds and six assists per contest (6.3 rpg, 6.5 apg). The other is Texas Southern's Kevin Galloway who is averaging 6.9 rebounds and 6.3 assists per game.

Undefeated on Thursday

Heading into its matchup with the Bulldogs, Liberty is undefeated (4-0) when playing on Thursday this season. The Flames hold victories over Presbyterian College (70-61, Dec. 2), Charleston Southern (68-54, Jan. 6), High Point (66-60, Jan. 13) and VMI (100-82, Jan. 20) on the fourth day of the week.

Minaya is Money

After posting single-digit scoring figures in four straight games, David Minaya is beginning to heat up. In the last three contests, the red shirt junior has averaged 15.6 tallies. Minaya is coming off a banner performance last Thursday, posting a career-high 22 points on 9-for-13 shooting (3-of-4 form three-point range) in Liberty's 100-82 win over VMI.

Keeping up with the Keydets

Despite entering the contest averaging just 4.8 three-pointers per game, Liberty nearly matched the nation's leader in three-pointers made per game last Thursday. The VMI Keydets hit 10 treys against the Flames last week. However, Liberty countered from behind the three-point arc, knocking down 9-of-11 (81.8 percent) long distance jumpers on the night.

The Big Disher

With 137 assists this season, Jesse Sanders accounts for 48.9 percent of the Flames total helpers (280) on the year.

8-1 Significance

Liberty's 8-1 start in conference play marks its best showing through the first eight league games in program history. The Flames have been 7-2 on three occasions (1991-92, 1992-93, 1996-97), but had not reached 8-1 until this season.

14 Wins

With 14 wins this season, the Flames are nearly a month ahead of where they were last year. During the 2009-10 campaign, Liberty did not garner its 14th win until Feb. 20, when the Flames defeated High Point inside the Vines Center, 76-67.

Double-Double Agent

With his 11-point, 14-rebound performance against Radford on Jan. 15, John Brown earned his fourth straight double-double and 10th this season. The most double-doubles posted in a single season by a Liberty player is 15. Only two Flames have achieved this feat - Mike Coleman (1990) and most recently Alex McLean.

Offensive/Defensive Rebound Percentage

The Flames are currently tops in the Big South conference in offensive rebounding percentage, grabbing offensive boards 39.9 percent of the time. Liberty is also No. 1 in defensive rebound percentage with 70.4 percent.

Triple-Double King

In Liberty's game versus Charleston Southern on Jan. 6, Jesse Sanders notched his third career triple-double, finishing with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists. The feat makes Sanders the first player in Liberty and Big South history to have three career triple-doubles.

Sanders has garnered each of his triple-doubles in the Vines Center. The Sugar Land, Texas native first accomplished the feat during his freshman season, posting identical totals against Presbyterian on Feb. 9, 2009. Last season, Sanders recorded his second triple-double against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12, 2009, finishing with 11 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists.

Milestone Man

With 1:48 remaining in the first half of Liberty's game against Radford on Jan. 15, Jesse Sanders notched his 500th career rebound. He is now the only player in Big South history to have at least 400 career assists and 500 rebounds. Sanders garnered his 400th assist in Liberty's contest against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 8. He currently has 426 helpers and 508 boards for his career.

Flames in January

Liberty enters Saturday's contest with a 165-165 record all-time in the month of January. The Flames finished the month with a 5-3 record last season. Liberty's best January showing occurred during the 1991-92 season, when the Flames went 8-2. That season, Liberty finished with a 22-7 record. This year, Liberty is off to a 5-1 start in January.

Recipe for Success

Liberty's level of success around the basket this season has been a good predictor of the Flames' outcome on the scoreboard.

When the Flames win the rebounding battle, they are 13-2. However, Liberty is 1-5 when being outrebounded. Similarly, Liberty is 12-2 when scoring more points in the paint than its opponent. Meanwhile, the Flames are only 2-5 when their opponent notches more points in the paint.

What Can Brown Do For You?

Liberty newcomer and redshirt-junior John Brown leads the Big South with 10.3 rebounds per game. If he can maintain his position, he would become the first Liberty player to lead the Conference in rebounding since Leo Lightbourne during the 2004-05 season. Brown could also become the first newcomer to finish as the Big South's top rebounder since High Point's Danny Gathings in 2002-03.

Hot Hand

In Liberty's game against Coastal Carolina, the Flames went 10-for 21 (47.6 percent) from the three-point arc, hitting the team's most treys since March 17, 2009, when the Flames went 10-for-23 (43.5 percent) against Rider in the opening round of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament. That season, Liberty set a program record for most three-pointers made in a season (321).

Enough About Favre ...

After starting 45 straight contests for the Flames, Jesse Sanders saw that streak come to an end against Union College on Dec. 28. The last time Sanders missed a start was March 17, 2009 against Rider in the opening round of the CollegeInsider.com Invitational Tournament (CIT). During his Liberty career, Sanders has appeared in 77 contests for the Flames, receiving the start 74 times.

Mistakes Made

During Liberty's game against Hampton on Dec. 22, the Flames committed 26 turnovers, their highest mark of the season. Liberty has committed 20 turnovers or more in three other games this season – 22 against UNC Asheville (Jan. 02) 25 against Gardner-Webb (Dec. 31), 23 against Mississippi Valley State (Nov. 26) and 20 against Chicago State (Nov. 27).

The last time Liberty committed 26 or more turnovers in a single game was Nov. 17, 2009, when the Flames (28) hosted Clemson during the ESPN Tipoff Marathon. Prior to this season, the last time a Liberty squad committed 20 turnovers or more on at least three occasions was the 2006-07 campaign. That season, the Flames committed 20-plus turnovers in a single game six times.

Brown's Rebounds

John Brown's Big South-leading rebounding average of 10.2 rpg has him on trackto become the first Flame to average double-digit rebounds since Liberty joined the BigSouth Conference.

The last Liberty player to average at least 10 rebounds per game for a whole seasonwas Mike Coleman, who tallied 10.1 rpg in 1990-91. That was the season before the Flames became a Big South member.

Chasing Dad

After scoring nine points in Liberty's contest against Radford on Saturday, Evan Gordon now has 670 career points. The sophomore's father, Eric Gordon, Sr., holds a place in the Liberty record books as a member of the 1,000-point club with 1,154 career points. The elder Gordon is 16th all-time on Liberty's scoring list.

Among the Nation's Best

John Brown and Jesse Sanders are both listed among the top 20 nationally in the latest NCAA statistical report. Brown is ranked No. 17 in the nation with10.2 rpg and is tied for No. 14 with 10 double-doubles. Meanwhile, Sanders sits at No. 8 nationally with 6.5 apg.

As a team, Liberty's highest national ranking is No. 12, thanks to its + 7.5 rebound margin (leads Big South).

Home Court Advantage?

The Flames are looking to improve its record at home this season, after finishing 8-6 (.571) inside the Vines Center last season. The winning percentage was the team's lowest since the 2005-2006 season, when the Flames went 6-7 (.462) at home. Liberty's lowest winning percentage inside the Vines Center occurred during the 1990-91 season, when the Flames went 3-8 (.375) during home games. The following season, Liberty turned things around, finishing the season 14-1 at home and claiming its best winning percentage in the Vines Center (.933).

The Brothers Sanders

After suiting up for the Flames for two seasons, starting point guard Jesse Sanders is joined this season by his younger brother, John Caleb. The brothers reunite after playing two seasons together with the HCYA Warriors (2006-07, 2007-08).

Jesse, who averaged 8.1 points, 6.7 rebounds and 4.9 assists per game last season, became the first player in Big South and school history to garner two career triple-doubles when he posted 11 points, 10 boards and 10 assists against Kentucky Christian on Dec. 12. Sanders' first three-category performance occurred during his freshman season against Presbyterian College.

Much like Liberty's floor general, John Caleb has spent his high school career in the Homeschool Christian Youth Association (HCYA), matching up with the top 5A and prep schools in the Houston area. During his junior year, he was named to the All Greater Houston third team, averaging 28 points per game, 8.9 rebounds per game and 4.7 assists per game. John Caleb helped the Warriors win three national homeschool championships, including one with his older brother.

Liberty-Nigeria Connection

Sommy Ogukwe, a 6-7 freshman forward from Abuja, Nigeria, is not the first Liberty player born in the African nation. In fact, two of the four players whose jerseys are retired at Liberty are Nigerian natives – Peter Aluma and Julius Nwosu.

Nwosu, who played three seasons for the Flames (1991-1993), is a member of Liberty's 1,000-point club, finishing his collegiate career with 1,248 points (14th all-time). Nwosu is also second on Liberty's all-time list in blocks with 112. The center was the first Liberty player to ever play in the NBA, suiting up for three different teams – the San Antonio Spurs (1995), the Boston Celtics (1997) and the Utah Jazz (2000). Nwosu is a native of Imo, Nigeria, which is approximately 372 miles from Ogukwe's hometown of Abuja.

Aluma, a four-year letterwinner and three-year starter at Liberty is seventh on Liberty's all-time scoring list with 1,715 career points. The former center holds the record for most blocks in a career by a Liberty payer with 366. In his freshman season with the Flames, he helped Liberty win its first Big South Championship and advance to its first ever NCAA Tournament in 1994. In 2008, he became the second Liberty athlete to be inducted into the Big South Hall of Fame. Aluma is a native of Lagos, Nigeria, which is approximately 466 miles from Abuja.
