Leader of Student Outreach: Since true IDentity is a ministry to university students, we aim to reach college students who long to know their Savior intimately. The purpose of this position is to provide a link between true IDentity and the college girls who are not part of our team. This member is responsible for "getting the word out" about our ministry, inviting girls to our discipleship studies and local events, and accountability groups, as well as for recruiting possible new members. She is to work in conjunction with the One Hope, which is the local university-based extension of true IDentity .
Leader of Event Counseling: This team member is responsible for aiding the Director in counseling ladies at our events. She is one who has a deep understanding of God's Word and who is discerning about what Scripture will meet individual needs. Though the Director also does counseling, this team member is responsible for reaching out to the needs of those individuals who we will meet during our events.
Leader of Drama and Special Segments : This team member is responsible for creating new dramas and special segments that will be used to communicate <i>God</i> 's truth during our event weekends. In addition to creating these, she is also responsible for suggesting to the Director their place and order during the events themselves.
Leader of Worship and Special Music: This team member is responsible for the leadership of our praise team as well as the order of worship during praise and worship time. She is to work in conjunction with the Leader of Drama and Special Segments in developing ideas for dramas that include special music. In addition to these responsibilities, she is also responsible for suggesting to the Director the order of worship during the events themselves.
Leader of Mentoring and Discipleship Coordinator: This team member is responsible for being a link between those we meet during events and the true IDentity team. She will be the coordinator of discipleship as she pairs those girls who desire accountability with a true IDentity team member that will serve as her continual contact. The girl will then be able to be held accountable by a true IDentity team member by way of email, etc. for as long as she desires. This leader will work hard to pair girls and team members whose personalities mesh so that they will have a fruitful accountability relationship.
Leader of Research and Teaching Development: This team member is responsible for researching youth and college culture and, in light of this research, coming up with new strategies and teaching methods to meet the specific needs of modern youth and college-aged young women. She will then present this material to the Director who will work with the other team members to develop strategies to include the material in future true IDentity events.
Leader/ Coordinator of Prayer Ministry: This team member is responsible for corresponding weekly with true IDentity prayer sponsors. She will inform them of events and will be a link for true IDentity and faithful prayer warriors. The role of prayer is vital in our ministry!
Leader of True Identity Care Ministry : This team member is responsible for outreach to each true IDentity member. She will keep track of birthdays as well as other significant events in team member's lives. She is the contact person if there is a specific prayer concern or need, and she works to keep the team unified and encouraged in the Lord.
