2011-2012 Diversity Grant Application

A Diversity Grant is available for undergraduate students who live on-campus, based upon the student's qualities that make Lincoln Memorial University a more diverse student body. Other criteria when considering students for the Diversity Grant will be grade point average, activities, leadership qualities, etc. The grant will equal \$2,000 per student for 2011-2012 to be used toward on-campus tuition, room and board expenses (after application of other aid). U.S. citizens and eligible non-citizens must complete a 2011-2012 FAFSA form in order to qualify for the Diversity Grant. All recipients must maintain a 2.7 cumulative grade point average and maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress in order for the award to be renewed annually. No application is necessary for renewal of Diversity Grant. Maximum timeframe to receive Diversity Grant is 8 semesters or 4 years.
