Graduating students may not enroll in any classes in a subsequent term until they have received a letter of admission for their new program.

Simplified Application Requirements

Students completing a master's degree or professional diploma program are not required to resubmit any documentation already provided that may be required for admission to a new program (e.g., transcripts, test scores). Please contact the Office of Graduate Studies and Continuing Education for requirements for specific programs.

Possible Financial Aid Implications

If a student received financial aid while enrolled in a current or previous degree or certificate program at New Jersey City University, please note that this eligibility for financial aid ends upon completion of that program of study. If a student wishes to continue to be eligible for financial aid for courses taken after completion of his/her of study, the student must first matriculate (be accepted into) the new program of study.
