Please bring this cover letter and the SAMPLE BANK LETTER (page 2 of this document) to your bank official. As stated below, make sure that they follow the bulleted guidelines! Following this format will ensure that the Italian Consulate does not reject your application on the basis of an incorrectly written bank letter.

Dear Bank Official,

The attached letter is a sample copy of the proof of financial means letter that the Italian consulate requires as part of the student visa application. Please follow the guidelines outlined below exactly in order to ensure that the letter is accepted by the consulate.

- Must be on official bank letterhead.
- Must indicate that a minimum of **\$4,100** is readily available in a savings or checking account.
- Must include exact balance including decimal amounts.
- Account holder must be the same as signer of the affidavit of financial support.
- **The letter must be notarized – but not by same bank official who signed it. If computer generated have account holder’s signature notarized.**
- When possible, have addressed to Consulate.
