

Financial Aid Application

There are two steps to the process of applying for financial aid at Northwest University: you must complete the federal financial aid form and the institutional financial aid form.

- 1. Complete all sections of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which can be done on the internet (www.fafsa.ed.gov). The Title IV Code for Northwest University is: 003783. (Make sure you complete the correct FAFSA for the Academic Year you will be attending, as FAFSA's are year specific.)
- 2. Complete this Northwest University Financial Aid Application and return it to: Northwest University, P.O. Box 579, Kirkland, WA 98083-0579.
