PURPOSE

ABCD's purpose is to improve and encourage the industry of bridge design, construction, and reconstruction by providing a forum for members to exchange and develop new ideas and techniques (www.abcd-susquehanna.org). This scholarship opportunity is offered to students who are considering a career in bridge engineering.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship amount is \$1,500.00 and will be awarded in April, 2010 at the annual ABCD Awards Banquet held in the Harrisburg, PA area.

• ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student in a civil engineering or civil engineering technology curriculum.
- 2. The applicant must have completed at least the sophomore year.
- 3. The applicant must either 1.) be enrolled at Bucknell University, Pennsylvania State University, Penn College of Technology, or Lehigh University or 2.) have a combination of a permanent residence within the boundaries of the Susquehanna Chapter Counties and attend another accredited engineering college or university within Pennsylvania. (Note: The Susquehanna Chapter counties include Adams, Centre, Clinton, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Lycoming, Mifflin, Montour, Northumberland, Perry, Potter, Snyder, Tioga, Union, and York.)

EVALUATION PROCEDURES

Each applicant will be evaluated using the rating system described below:

- Grade Point Average
 30 points maximum
 Students will be rated based upon their cumulative grade point average as reflected in college
 transcripts.
- 2. Honors and Activities

 Students will be rated based upon a subjective evaluation of activities, honors, and employment history. While honors associated with grade point average considered above should be included, particular emphasis in this category will be given to honors and activities separate and distinct from those associated with grade point average.
- 4. Student essay
 Student's essay (not to exceed two pages) will be subjectively rated. Rating will be based on subject, content, and presentation including grammar and spelling. Essay can be about any bridge related topic of the student's choice.

INSTRUCTIONS: Supply all applicable information as requested below. Type or print clearly. Attach one copy of Transcript of Grades. Attach essay. Have civil engineering or civil technology Department Head certify applicant's student status and eligibility for scholarship.
