



Deed-for-Lease™ Program Cancellation Form

Instructions: This form should be used by property managers and servicers.

- Property managers should use it to notify Fannie Mae that a borrower or property is ineligible for a property lease-back offer or that the property manager was unable to contact the borrower and therefore the case should be considered closed.
- Servicers should use it to notify Fannie Mae that the borrower is no longer eligible for a deed-in-lieu of foreclosure (DIL).
