- ✚ You must maintain a 2.25 G.P.A.
- ✚ You must be a good college citizen

- ✚ You must be admitted to the University.
- ✚ You must have paid your \$200 deposit.
- ✚ You must file a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form or submit a letter indicating you have no financial need.
