A. Incoming Freshman

Meet one of the following: Score of 1200 on the SAT (critical reading + math) **OR** 27 on the composite ACT **OR** top 10 percent of your high school class. **Scholarship deadline: February 1; Application deadline: June 30 (Final)**

B. SHSU Undergraduate Student

Meet both of the following: (1) Cumulative SHSU GPA of 3.40 or higher; and (2) Freshman or Sophomore status *only*.

C. Transfer Student

Meet both of the following: (1) Cumulative transfer GPA of 3.40 or higher; and (2) Freshman or Sophomore status *only*.

HONORS COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIPS

To qualify for the Elliott T. Bowers Scholarship, the Richard A. Cording Scholars Endowment Fund Scholarship, the Augusta Lawrence Scholarship, or other awards, students must be in good standing in the Honors College.

- The Elliott T. Bowers Scholarship is awarded to all incoming Honors College students and is conditionally renewable for up to four years totaling up to \$2,800.
- The Richard A. Cording Scholars Endowment Fund Scholarship is available to incoming freshmen accepted into the Honors College. This scholarship is valued at \$1000 per year for up to two years. To ensure consideration for the Richard A. Cording Scholars Scholarship, completed applications must be received by February 1st.
- The Augusta Lawrence Scholarship is available to juniors and seniors. This writing competition scholarship is valued at \$1,000.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Undergraduate Academic Achievement Scholarship is a competitive scholarship awarded to SHSU undergraduate and transfer students whose academic accomplishments and university or community citizenship are excellent in every respect. This competitive scholarship is intended for a full-time student enrolled as a resident, nonresident or citizen of a country other than the United States of America, maintaining not less than a 3.25 GPA. This award amount is determined on the availability of funds. Application deadline is February 1. Late applications may be accepted pending funds available.

GULF COAST INTERCOLLEGIATE HONORS COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP

Honors College students transferring from an honors program at a Gulf Coast Intercollegiate Honors Council (GCIHC) member school and admitted to the Elliott T. Bowers Honors College at SHSU will be eligible for the GCIHC Scholarship. This scholarship is valued at \$1,000 and will be available fall and spring of your first year at SHSU. Applications may be obtained from and should be submitted to the Honors College Directors within the GCIHC. Application deadline is February 1st.
