- 1. A completed application form for Graduate Admission.
- 2. A non-refundable \$30 application fee (check payable to Spalding University).
- 3. One OFFICIAL transcript from EACH college or university attended, sent directly to the Spalding University Admissions Office. **Transcripts marked "issued to student" are not considered official transcripts.**
- 4. Official GRE or MAT scores sent directly to Spalding University (the ETS Institutional Code is R1552).
- 5. TOEFL scores required from those for whom English is a second language. (If the GRE or MAT is taken prior to admission, the TOEFL requirement is waived.)
- 6. International students are required to submit an Affidavit of Financial Support.
- 7. Application/Information as required by individual program (see insert).
