**Recognizing that poster format can be too restrictive for non-science disciplines, we are including oral and creative presentations as well. This format has become popular over the past four years, and we would like to encourage more students to take advantage of this opportunity.** Please ask your students to be specific about their format needs when completing the attached form. Scholarly work that has been previously presented or published elsewhere is welcome. Students may also submit work in progress. We are excited about this opportunity to recognize the scholarly and creative work of students and their faculty mentors. Students who participate in the event will be awarded a certificate and receive a commemorative gift from the University.
