REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS

Texas State law requires that students have the following immunizations: **-Diphterial/Tetanuse (DTP, Dtap, DT, Td):** 3 doses including one received on or after the 4th birthday, and one within the past ten years.

-Polio (OPV, IPV): 3 doses, including one received on or after the 4th birthday.

-Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR): (usually given in combination as MMR)
*Measles – students must show proof of two doses of measles vaccine
- 2 doses on or after the 1st birthday (2nd dose may be part of 2nd MMR)
*Mumps – one dose on or after the 1st birthday
*Rubella (German Measles) – one dose on or after the 1st birthday

-Hepatitis B: 3 doses for children born between September 2, 1988 and September 1, 1992 (inclusive)

-Varicella (chicken pox): 1 dose for children born between September 2, 1988 and September 1, 1994 (inclusive) received within thirty days after their 1st birthday. If first dose is received after age thirteen, two doses are required. (A letter from the parent or doctor is acceptable if the student has had Varicella.)

(A blood test showing immunity to the disease will be accepted if the vaccine has not been given.)

MSA recommends that students get a Meningitis shot. Although rare, there is a higher occurrence of Meningitis when living in close quarters.

EXEMPTION FROM IMMUNIZATIONS

A physician's statement is required to exempt a child from immunizations or a letter from the parent to exempt the child for religious reasons.
