All applicants must have a **FAFSA** on file in the Financial Aid Office in order to be considered for this award. The award may be in the form of a scholarship or to assist the student with child care, medical expenses, commuting and transportation and for school-related supplies and materials. The main criterion is to support a nontraditional student who is having difficulty in his/her pursuit of a college degree because of extraordinary financial challenges.

**Award Amount:** \$750 **Application Deadline:** 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in April **Award Notification:** Mid-June. *Only the selected recipient will be notified of the award determination.* 

Note: Students enrolling under **"Special Student" status** are not eligible for most Financial Aid/scholarships. They are, however, eligible to apply for the Returning Student Grant which is offered fall and spring semesters. Also Note: Due to State regulation you may be ineligible to receive a scholarship if you are delinquent in child support payments. Please check with Financial Aid if you have questions.
