- 2. A check or money order for \$60.00 payable to "UW-Stevens Point" for the application fee.
- OFFICIAL transcripts from all colleges (both undergraduate and graduate) you attended. The transcript from the college from which you graduated must indicate that you earned a bachelor's degree.
 **Transcripts must be sent in a sealed university envelope directly from that institution to the UW-Stevens Point Foreign Student Office, Nelson Hall, 1209 Fremont Street, UWSP, Stevens Point, WI, 54481-3897. Transcripts "issued to the student" are not acceptable.
- 4. A statement or certificate indicating English language proficiency. The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) is recommended. A score of **550** is required (**575 for the Master of Arts in Communication**).
- 5. Documented evidence of financial stability for one year. The amount must be in U.S. dollars. Please provide a statement from your sponsor's bank or your bank including the amount of money on deposit for your education.
- 6. Admission to the specific degree program.
