2. Courses identified by an asterisk (*) on the front of this sheet are sequential and must be taken in separate semesters. This is a 5-semester sequence begun in the fourth semester. Students must begin this sequence in the fourth semester in order to graduate in four years.

- C. A Mid-Program Portfolio Review is a requirement for graduation.
- D. **GRADE REQUIREMENTS:** A grade of "C" (2.0) or better in each Art and Design Department class (those with an ART/ARTH/DES prefix) is required for graduation, as well as, a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or better in Art and Design Department courses and a 2.0 overall GPA is required for graduation.
- E. **EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING REQUIREMENT:** One of the following experiences must be completed as a requirement for graduation: internship, co-op, international study abroad, field experience or sponsored project (the sponsored project must be approved by the BFA in Graphic Design and Interactive Media Program Director).
