## **Refrigerator and Microwave Opportunities for First Year Students**

Dear Members of the Class of 2011,

Bowdoin College has a strong history of environmental stewardship within the higher education community. In recent years the College has committed to the Maine Governor's Carbon Challenge and is continually making efforts to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions. As a student at Bowdoin, you will have a large part to play in our effort to make the campus environmentally sustainable. **One action that we are encouraging all incoming first year students to support is the installation of energy star rated mini-fridges in your dorm room.** While electrical appliances such as refrigerators and microwaves are not discouraged, we hope that any appliances you do install achieve the Energy Star rating developed by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The Energy Star certification is awarded by the EPA to products that use less energy, save money and are better for the environment.

Bowdoin is offering a special program with University Electronics for students who would be interested in renting the most efficient Energy Star model available – the MicroFridge. The MicroFridge is actually a microwave, refrigerator and freezer all in one unit. University Electronics will save you the trip of carrying a microwave and a refrigerator to your dorm room by having the MicroFridge waiting for you upon arrival. They will also pick it up from your dorm room at the end of the year. Please see the enclosed flyer with all the details about the MicroFridge and the University Electronics rental program. One easy way to know if your purchase has achieved the Energy Star standard is to look for the Energy Star label on the appliance. ## **Rental Agreement**

The Student/Renter hereby agrees to rent one combination refrigerator/freezer/microwave from University Electronics for the academic year, according to the following terms:

1. University Electronics shall, during this agreement, keep and maintain the Unit in good working condition, reasonable wear and tear alone is accepted. University Electronics will at its own expense replace or repair any Unit should said Unit fail to operate normally, except those that are damaged through misuse, negligence, carelessness or irresponsible use by the student renter.

2. Unit said must be thoroughly cleaned, defrosted, dry and ready for storage upon return to University Electronics.

3. The unit must have all parts and accessories included when returned.

4. Student renter understands that the Unit requires a grounded outlet. If the room is not equipped with a 3 prong grounded outlet, a grounded 3 prong adaptor must be used. If an extension cord is used, it must be heavy duty. (Surge protectors recommended).

5. The Student Renter herby gives permission to University Electronics to charge back or bill for any and all non-returned parts or accessories or damages to either Unit from any type of abuse or misuse.
