FOR EMPLOYEE DEPENDENT CHILDREN

Caterpillar established this special scholarship fund at Bradley University, as part of the company's commitment to Bradley's Centennial Campaign, to benefit the dependent children of Caterpillar employees, retirees, and deceased employees. These scholarships are funded by Caterpillar through annual contributions from the Caterpillar Excellence Fund. The specific amount of each scholarship will be determined by Bradley's Office of Financial Assistance up to \$2,500 per scholarship recipient and is restricted to tuition.

Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Recipient must be a legal dependent child of a current, retired, or deceased full-time employee of Caterpillar Inc. or any wholly-owned subsidiary that is eligible for Caterpillar provided health insurance.
- 2. Recipient must have applied for admission to Bradley University no later than **February 1** for first-time freshman or **April 1** for transfer students.
- 3. Renewal of scholarship is dependent upon reapplication, maintaining a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and being a full-time student in any of the undergraduate programs.

Application Process:

Complete this application and return it to Bradley's Office of Financial Assistance. Eligible applicants are assured of full consideration if this application is received by **March 1**st.

Selection Process:

The scholarship selection process will be coordinated by the Office of Financial Assistance at Bradley University in accordance with the guidelines outlined in this scholarship description. In all cases, preference will be given students demonstrating a defined financial need and/or high academic achievement.

Dependents of Bradley University employees who receive Tuition Remission benefits and also qualify for the Caterpillar Scholarship may not have total assistance from these two sources that exceeds the recipient's annual tuition costs.

Scholarship Renewal:

While scholarship renewal is not guaranteed, it is likely that awards will continue each year so long as the student meets the eligibility criteria stated above. Award amounts may vary from year to year depending upon available funding. **RECIPIENTS MUST REAPPLY EVERY YEAR!!**
