Classroom Mentor

OSU is seeking 10 Veteran Master Gardeners to serve as mentors during the classroom training (March to May). Veterans can attend the full training at **no** charge. Veterans will also receive all handouts, supplies, etc., at **no** charge. *Apply soon!* Veterans will be notified no later than February 25 regarding the status of their application.

Training

Due to limited seating in the OSU Extension auditorium, Veteran Master Gardeners will be asked to select the classes they would like to attend. In order to reserve seats, Veterans must sign up for the class well in advance. Seating is based on a first-come, first-serve basis. Because there are only **10** extra seats available per class, we are asking that Veterans limit their selection to *four* classes. Veterans will be notified prior to the class regarding the status of their class selection. In order to offer this option at **no cost**, all handouts will be posted on the OSU website and will have to be downloaded and printed prior to class.
