GENERAL INFORMATION AND ELIGIBILITY

The program extension form is to be used by an F-1 student who is unable to complete his or her course of study by the program end date on form I-20. The extension request must be submitted to the Center for International Education at least 30 days before the end date of the I-20 and cannot be submitted more than 1 semester prior to the end date. You are eligible if you have been maintaining status, if you have been making normal progress toward degree completion, and if academic suspension has not delayed your completion. A student who fails to request an extension prior to the program end date will be considered out of status and must apply to USCIS for reinstatement.
