- All candidates must adhere to all of the campaign rules and policies. Any violation of the campaign rules will constitute disqualification from the election.
- All elected positions must attend the SGA Senator Retreat on September 21-22, 2012 where all new officers will be installed for the 2012-2013 Academic Term.
