## **General Information**

### What is the deadline for filing this return?

This return is due on or before the twentieth day following the end of the quarter for which you are filing this return. For example, if this return is for the quarter ending March 31, it is due on or before April 20.

# What if I fail to file this return and pay the amount I owe?

You owe a **late-filing penalty** if you do not file a processable return by the due date, **a late-payment penalty** if you do not pay the tax you owe by the date the tax is due, and a **bad check penalty** if your remittance is not honored by your financial institution. Interest is calculated on tax from the day after the original due date of your return through the date you pay the tax. We will bill you for penalties and interest. For more information about penalties and interest, See Publication 103, Penalties and Interest. In addition, we may suspend or revoke your bingo license.

## **Specific Instructions**

### Step 1: Identify your organization

Write your organization's license number, name, and address. Answer the questions to the right of your organization's information.

### Step 2: Identify your supplier

Write the license number, name, and address of your supplier. If you have more than two, please attach a separate sheet of paper.

### Step 3: List your weekly bingo games

You must complete the session date and the value of prizes awarded for each weekly bingo event in order of play. For example, the first weekly bingo game of the quarter should be written on Line 1.

Note: Please be sure to write the total number of games held.

### Step 4: Figure your tax due

Value of prizes awarded - the amount of all cash prizes awarded, including door or attendance prizes, and the cash value of any merchandise or bingo cards awarded as prizes.

**Number of bingo players -** the total number of bingo players at each event.

**Gross proceeds -** the receipts from each event. According to the Bingo License and Tax Act, "gross proceeds" includes the charge, in whatever form, for playing bingo.

**Line 15 -** Write the total number of players and gross proceeds from your weekly games.

**Line 16, 17, and 18 -** Write your special permit number, the first and last day of the event, the value of prizes, the number of players, and the gross proceeds for that event.

**Lines 21 -** If you have a credit you wish to apply toward your tax, write the amount of credit you wish to apply on Line 21.

**Lines 22 -** This is the total amount of tax you owe. If you do not file a processable return or pay the tax you owe by the due date, you will owe additional penalty and interest. We will bill you for penalties and interest. If you prefer to figure these amounts, see the most current Publication 103, Penalties and Interest, because application of penalties and interest may be different depending on when your return is due. Include the penalty and interest amounts on Line 22. Please identify how much is penalty and interest to the left of Line 22.

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
