**MASTER OF EDUCATION (M.ED.)
ADMISSION, MAINTENANCE AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Must have a Class A Certificate issued by a state department of education, or must have completed a teacher education program accredited by NCATE.**
- 2. Must have at least twelve semester hours of undergraduate courses in education and psychology. (Only three semester hours in psychology will count.)**
- 3. Must have eighteen hours of undergraduate courses in the teaching field in which the graduate degree will be pursued.**
- 4. Must have made a composite score of 1000 or better on the old NTE or have the State minimum scores on the three sections of the newer NTE Core Battery (Communication Skills - 651; General Knowledge - 646; Professional Knowledge - 649) or met State minimum scores in the Praxis I tests: PPST Reading - 170 or CBT Reading - 316; PPST Writing - 172 or CBT Writing - 318; PPST Math - 169 or CBT Math - 314.**
- 5. Must have met or surpassed the State minimum score of 530 on the Praxis II ART Specialty Test.**
- 6. Must maintain a 3.0 quality point average.**
- 7. At least 50% of course in program must be taken at the 6000 level.**
- 8. No degree requirement may be waived without the approval of the Graduate Dean.**
 - Make application for graduation with the Registrar's Office.
(The diploma is ordered from this information)**
 - Apply for Oral-Written Comprehensive Examination with the Graduate Office.**

At the END of the last semester, fill out a transcript request form and application for licensure which will be sent to the State Department of Education. (These forms are available in the Teacher Education Office in Lowrey Hall.)
