- Special event parking where organizers have obtained prior permission for free parking in Lots 21, 22 or 23.

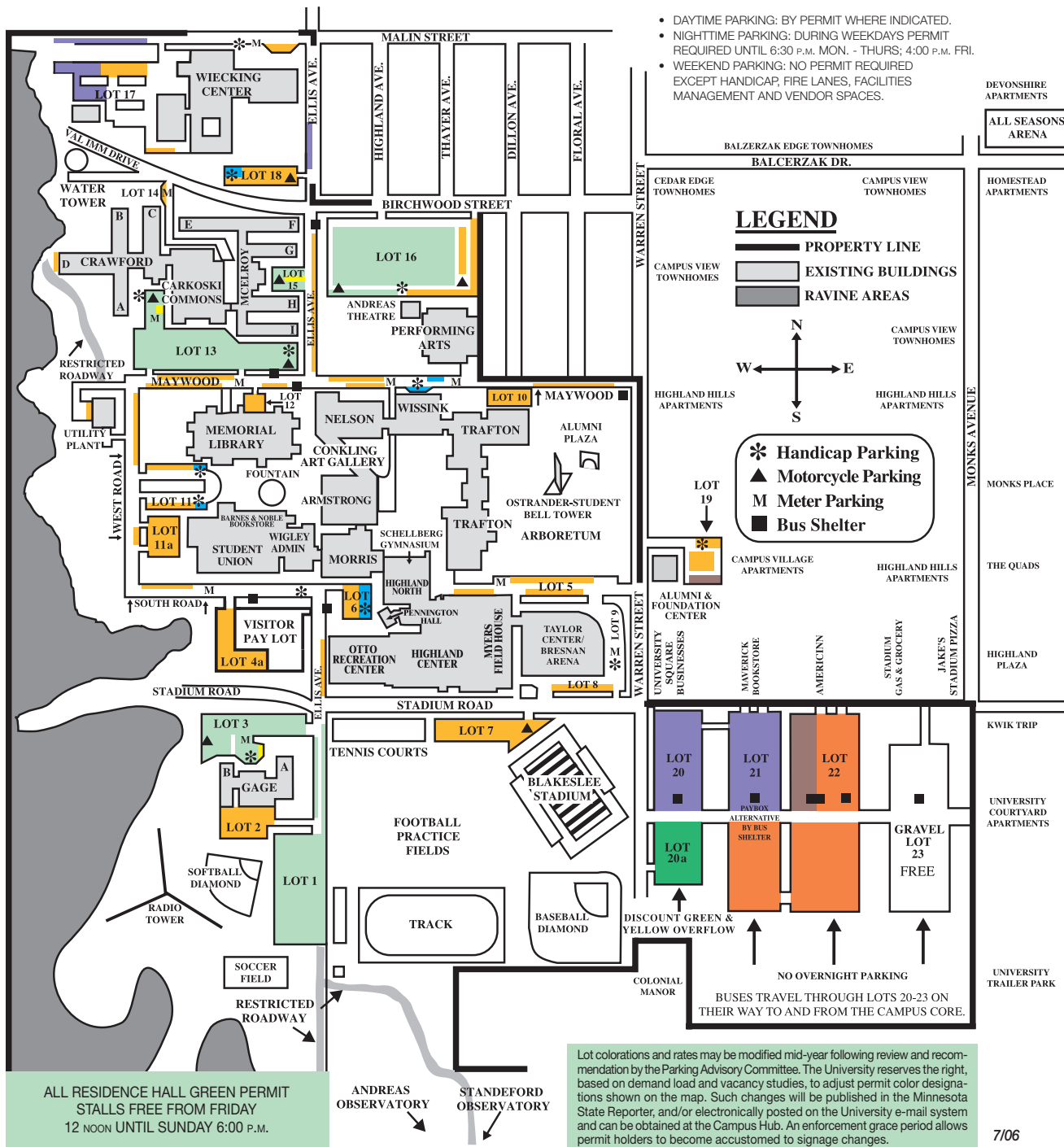

G Gold	Gold \$230 Twelve-month year; \$138 Spring; \$46 Summer Gold permit holders can only park in their designated gold permit lot or in a purple permit stall. After 4:00 P.M. they can park in any gold permit stall regardless of the lot designation on the face of the gold parking permit. Nighttime gold permits are available to purple permit holders (both an individual's purple and nighttime gold must be hanging at the same time). Nighttime gold may park in any regular gold permit stall after 4:00 P.M. Monday thru Thursday.	\$230 \$20 per semester
P Purple	Purple \$130 Academic year; \$65 Spring Purple permit holders can park in purple permit stalls or orange permit stalls. FREE Bus Tag and nighttime Red Eye Shuttle service provided. Nighttime purple permits allow night class students to park in any purple stall Monday thru Thursday from 4:00 P.M. to 2:00 A.M.	\$130 \$70 Fall \$35 Spring
O Orange	Orange - Lots 21 & 22 only \$94 Academic year; \$47 Spring FREE Bus Tag provided.	\$94
GR Green	Green - Close-In On-Campus Residence Hall Parking \$166 Academic year; \$83 Spring Residence hall parking is divided into two zones: the Gage Area Zone includes Lots 1 and 3 and Ellis Ave. on-street stalls east of Gage A Tower; the McElroy/Crawford Zone includes Lots 13, 15 and 16 (except Reserved Gold stalls). Must be a residence hall student during 2006-07.	\$166
DGR Dark Green	Dark Green - More-Distant On-Campus Residence Hall Parking \$70 Academic year; \$35 Spring Discount residence hall parking. Dark green permit holders park in Lot 20a, or if full, Lot 21 South. CCTV camera monitors are located in Lot 20. Must be a residence hall student. FREE Bus Tag and nighttime Red Eye Shuttle service provided.	\$70
LB Light Blue	Light Blue - Vendor Delivery Services Zone \$230 Twelve-month year; \$138 Spring; \$46 Summer Must park in specially signed areas; A paper "temporary" permit is available for \$5 per day, \$15 per week.	\$230
DB Dark Blue	Dark Blue - Handicap \$94 Twelve-month year; \$54 Spring; \$13 Summer Holders of the handicap permit can park in any handicap stall or if full, any gold permit, purple permit, green permit, yellow permit, or time meter stalls. For University students or employees a special University blue hanging handicap permit is required beyond the state issued handicap dashboard permits or license plates. The University permit required 6:00 A.M. to 6:30 P.M. Monday thru Thursday; 6:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. Friday. Handicap dashboard certificate and/or license plate required at all times. Nighttime handicap permits required during the academic year until 6:30 P.M. Monday thru Thursday; 4:00 P.M. Friday.	\$94

S Silver - Motorcycle	Academic Year Permit Must park in specially signed areas.	\$60 or \$30 with other permit
White Complimentary	Holders of the white permit (media, community leaders, emeriti faculty and other retirees) can park in general purple or orange stalls when visiting the campus on weekdays. White permit holders can park in gold permit stalls during summer.	No Charge
I Ivory	Temporary Hanging Permit Temporary Ivory paper hanging permits are available for short term parking - location determined at time of purchase. \$5 per day/\$15 per week; \$10 minimum for handicap; Lot 20a residence hall student parking \$5 minimum/\$10 per week.	
B Brown	Contract Parking Lot 19 and 22 Brown Contract Parking plastic permits are only available to University Square Village tenants and are issued by University Square Village, not MSU.	
R Red	Red - \$40 Academic year; \$18 Spring Overnight parking for MSU night shift employees in special designated areas. Gold, Purple, and Orange permit holders may apply for a red overnight permit which are issued free by facilities services manager. Both the red and regular permit must be hung at the same time.	\$40
Y Yellow	Yellow - Residence Hall Guest Must park in yellow signed stalls close to each residence hall or may park in green stalls Thursday Noon to Sunday 6:00 P.M. during academic year. Lot 20a remains the overflow lot for yellow permit holders. Permits issued by residence hall complex front desks.	No Charge
