

WORKSHOP FACULTY



Saxophonist and clarinetist **Shannon Ford** has performed throughout the Midwest with Sax 4th Avenue and recorded the two Suites for Tenor Saxophone and Strings with the Alec Wilder Project, along with other CD releases. Performing often with the Toledo Jazz Orchestra and the Toledo Symphony, she is a member of the Scott Gwinnell Jazz Orchestra and is principal clarinet with the Lima Symphony Orchestra. She teaches saxophone at Oakland University and both saxophone and clarinet at Adrian College, having earned performance degrees from Indiana State University and Bowling Green State University.

Mark Kieme has performed on over 100 CDs and several hundred ads and soundtracks. A University of Michigan School of Music alum, he is a member of the Paul Keller Orchestra, The Johnny Trudell Big Band, The Craig Strain Orchestra, The Motor City Jazz Orchestra and founding member of The Detroit Reed Collective. He performs regularly with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra and released his first solo recording in early 2007.



Gregory Cunningham is the Doris and Paul Travis Associate Professor of Music at Oakland University (Rochester, MI), where he serves as Director of Bands, and teaches orchestral/wind conducting at the graduate and undergraduate levels. In addition to his 2010 appointment as Music Director of the Warren Symphony Orchestra (Warren, MI), Dr. Cunningham concurrently serves as the Music Director and Principal Conductor of the Oakland Symphony Orchestra, another Southeastern Michigan semi-professional orchestra that is "in residence" at Oakland University.





Sharon Sparrow has been a flutist with the Detroit Symphony for the past 11 years, most recently completing a year as Principal Flutist after winning a highly competitive international audition. An active orchestral, solo and chamber musician in Michigan and the United States, Ms. Sparrow has been noted for her artistry, exquisite tone and musical interpretations. In addition to her positions in Detroit, she has also performed with the Eastern Philharmonic Orchestra, Memphis Symphony, Fort Wayne Philharmonic, and the Hong Kong Philharmonic. She received her Bachelor of Music from the Juilliard School and her Master of Music from Mannes College of Music, both in New York City.
