The Honors Program is a program designed for students who have demonstrated exceptional academic skill, or who have the desire to explore areas above and beyond the normal classroom requirements. In order to participate in the program students must meet the following requirements:

- a) New Incoming Students (Freshmen) must meet two of the following criteria:
 - 1) Cumulative ACT of 27 (or above)
 - 2) 3.5 GPA/4.0 Scale
 - 3) Graduate in the top 10% of their high school graduating class

- b) Sophomores, Juniors, Transfers, and Non-Traditional students must be in possession of a:
 - 1) Cumulative ACT of 27 (or above)
 - 2) 3.5 GPA/4.0 Scale
