Amenities

What Does Each Apartment Come With?

Furniture

Each apartment comes fully furnished. For questions or concerns about your furniture, please contact reslife@regis.edu

Balconies

Each apartment has its own balcony. Open flame grills are not allowed.

Laundry

A laundry room is available on the first floor of the complex at no cost to residents. Please be attentive to time when doing laundry as a courtesy to the other residents. Never leave your laundry overnight or leave the building with clothes in the washer or dryer. Residence Life is not responsible for any lost or stolen garments. If problems with the laundry facility occur, please contact the Residence Life Coordinator. Refer to page 12 for contact numbers.

Parking

Parking is free at Pomponio Village and on the Regis campus. Please visit Campus Safety for an on-campus parking pass.

Overall Security?

As a department, our first priority is creating a safe and secure living environment for our residents. To ensure that Pomponio Village remains a safe place to live, the following are in place:

Secured Entry

The front and back doors of the apartment complex are accessible by residents' swipe cards or by the guest-access system available in each apartment. Please ensure you know the person at the front door before letting them into the complex. For lost swipe cards, contact the Residence Life Coordinator.

Apartment Security

Each apartment is accessible by key. Residents are encouraged to keep their doors locked at all times. The Department of Residence Life is not responsible for any unauthorized entry or stolen items from unlocked apartments. For lost keys, contact the Residence Life Coordinator.

Security Cameras

Currently, there are six security cameras surrounding the apartment complex. These cameras are used as a reference in Pomponio related incidents.

Fire

In case of a fire, please call 911 immediately, then contact Regis Campus Safety. For general fire prevention, please; 1) Never leave the oven on unattended, 2) Observe the No Smoking policy, 3) Keep a box of baking soda in your kitchen in case of a grease fire, 4) Do not overload power outlets, 6) Be aware that there are fire extinguishers in the hallways.

A Few Suggestions:

To increase your safety, here are a few suggestions:

- Keep your doors and windows closed and locked when you are not home
- Keep bed room doors locked when you are not home
- If you have a car make sure to lock it during the day and night
- Leave one light inside the house on at all times unless you are out of town

How To Live

The Pomponio Village is considered a Residence Hall of Regis University, and as such the residents are held to the same rules that apply to the other halls as described in the Regis University handbook. Each student has a copy of the handbook and is responsible for what is written in them regardless of if they have read it or not. If you do not have a Regis University Handbook, please contact your Residence Life Coordinator for one.

Below are just some general reminders that apply to the Pomponio Village.

Alcohol Policy

Residents that are 21 years of age or older are allowed to have and drink alcohol inside their apartment. Anyone inside the apartment that is under 21 including residents and guests are not allowed to drink. Guest of those that are over 21 are allowed to consume alcohol as well. However guests that are over 21 visiting someone who is under 21 are not allowed to drink. There is also no drinking out side of the apartments in the parking lot or on the patios/decks. Smoking Policy

Smoking is not allowed in any Pomponio apartments, balconies, or hallways. If one wishes to smoke, they must be at least 25 feet away from the building as described in the student handbook.
