TALENT SHOW RULES and REGULATIONS

Dear Parents and Students,

The 3rd annual "Classical Academies Got Talent!" will take place on Saturday, October 27, 2012 at the Moonlight Amphitheatre in Vista. Please read the information below and, if participating, sign the form. Your signature indicates that both parent and prospective talent show members have read this information, understand this information, and agree to abide by the guidelines set forth. Students without a signed audition form will not be allowed to audition. Thank you for your cooperation and support. We are looking forward to a great show!

Auditions will be held at each individual school on the following dates:

September 24, 9 AM-11:50 AM-California Center for the Arts-Room G140 (Dance Room)

September 24, 3 PM-6 PM-The Classical Academy-Room L1

September 27, 3 PM-6 PM-Coastal Academy-Assembly Room

ATTENTION! It is required that one parent volunteer to work a shift to help manage talent back stage if your student is chosen to be in the show. Note: your shift will not be during your child's performance. A mandatory volunteer meeting will be held at the Moonlight Amphitheatre the week of the event; date TBD.

1. Auditions are open to all current Classical Academies students.
2. We do ask that all students leave after their audition.
3. Acts must be no more than 3 minutes in length. An act that runs longer may be selected under the condition that it may be trimmed to a fit the show length.
4. The show will be approximately 1 ½ hours long. There will be approximately 25 acts selected, possibly more or less depending on the timing of the acts chosen.
5. The maximum number of acts for any one student in which to participate are 2.
6. The maximum number of participants for ALL acts is 12 people.
7. In all cases, decisions of the judges are final and will not be open to discussion or debate.
8. Tryouts are closed to anyone other than students who are auditioning and the judges. This includes relatives, friends, and other Classical Academy students. The exception is if you have an accompanist for a song, and it happens to be a family member!

9. PARTICIPATION IS A PRIVILEGE! Participating students must maintain Classical Academies academic and behavior standards. Students who do not maintain these standards will not be permitted to perform.

10. The show will be performed on **Saturday, October 27, 2012** at the Moonlight Amphitheatre in Vista. Performers must arrive by their assigned "Sound Check" time or they will be dropped from the show.

RULES ABOUT ACTS:

A) We want students who enter this show to exhibit their talent. Talents might include (but are not limited to) singing, dancing, instrumental music, skits, magic, juggling.

No lip-synching or bands that require set-up and tear-down time please.

B) No act will be considered if it does not meet the judges' standards of appropriateness for school in terms of language, subject matter, and attire.

C) Acts are responsible for their own music, props and costumes. Preferably music should be provided on a CD or iPod; a piano will be available but you must provide the accompanist. (Cassettes are not an option)

Although complete costumes and props are not necessary for auditions, the more complete and polished an act is at audition time, the greater chance it will have of getting into the show.

F) Failure to attend your scheduled sound check time, except in the case of illness or extreme emergency-- will result in your being excluded from the show.

G) Selected acts are responsible for rehearsing and polishing on their own. If the act has been changed from its original audition without prior permission, or, if it is not adequately prepared, it will be dropped from the show.
