The Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended and final regulations set by the United States Department of Education, requires that Tuskegee University establish reasonable standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP). Financial aid recipients are expected to make reasonable progress as a condition of receiving and continuing to receive student financial aid. Due to your failure of meeting the Tuskegee University's minimum standards governing Satisfactory Academic Progress, you must appeal the suspension of your financial aid by the specified deadline. In order to appeal you must submit this form, along with the required supporting documentation of the extenuating circumstances which have affected your academic progress. Only valid appeals will be review by the Financial Aid Appeals Committee. A valid appeal includes the Appeal Form, the Academic Progress Plan, and the Appeal Statement. Incomplete appeals will not be reviewed and will automatically be DENIED and WILL NOT be reviewed again for the term submitted. Only appeals with documented extenuating circumstances will be considered. Appeals received after the deadline date will be considered for the next term. Decisions on completed appeals should be available within two weeks after grades are posted. All decisions by the Committee are final and cannot be appealed further. The status of your appeal request will be submitted to your TU e-mail address so be sure and monitor your e-mail account for the decision. An approved appeal decision may impose limitations upon your financial aid eligibility and/or future minimum academic standards.
