

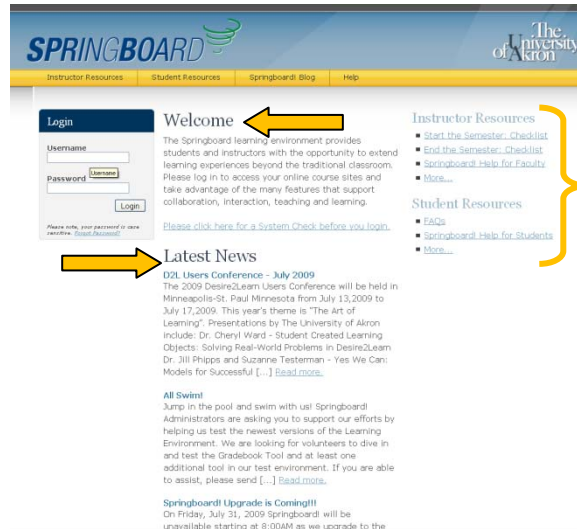
New Springboard! Login Page

1. Go to <http://springboard.uakron.edu>

A new login page will appear. This page is similar in format to The University of Akron's website.

This page contains a great deal of information for all users of Springboard!

You will see a Welcome message, Latest News, and links to additional Resources.

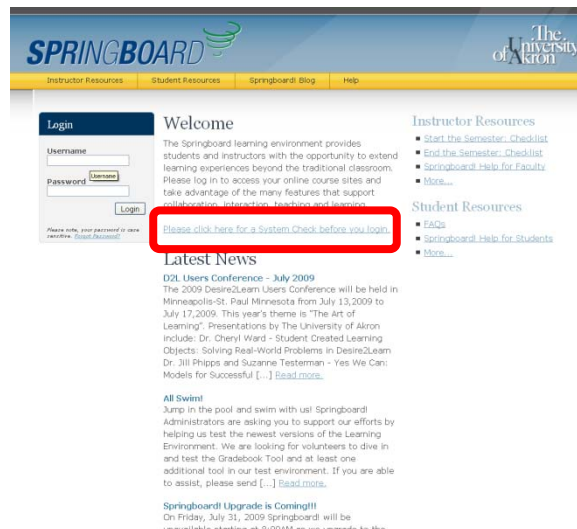


2. Before you login to Springboard!, it is recommended that all users perform a System Check to be sure you have the recommended software installed on your computer.

This quick check is vital to making your experience in Springboard! a pleasant and productive one.

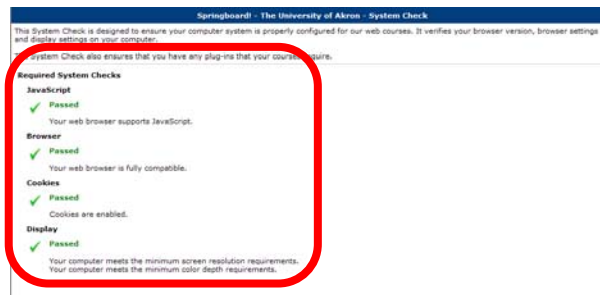
Beneath the Welcome message is the following text: **"Please click here for a System Check before you login"**.

Click on the sentence hyperlink. Once clicked, a new browser status window will open.



3. This new status window provides verification about browser version, browser settings and display settings on the computer you are using. These are all vital components for utilizing Springboard! effectively and efficiently.

The screen reports back to the user that the current computer has all Required System plug-ins and appropriate settings to work with Springboard! --- this computer has Passed.



It is important to perform this System Check on all computers that you use to access Springboard!

Once finished, you can close this window and return to the login page.


