2011-2012 Windgate Foundation Scholarships

Use of Scholarships:

The \$4000.00 Windgate Foundation Scholarships may be used for tuition and fees, books and art materials only for the academic year of 2011-2012, excluding summer. The scholarship will be awarded in two installment with the first half paid in at the beginning of the fall semester and the second at the beginning of the spring semester. Students must remain eligible in order to receive the second installment.

Recipient Qualifications:

- The recipients shall be full- or part-time degree seeking students who are declared majors in the Department of Art.
- Recipients in art history must show evidence of strong academic accomplishments through two research papers.
- Recipients in studio art and applied design must show evidence of strong artistic accomplishment through a visual portfolio of their own artwork.
- Recipients in art education must show strong academic or strong artistic accomplishment through a research paper or a visual portfolio of their own artwork.
- Students must be in "Good" academic standing with the university.
- Recipients shall write a letter of appreciation to the Donors, which shall serve as their official notice of acceptance.

Selection Process:

The art department scholarship committee will identify candidates based on the Recipient Qualifications and Application Materials stated above. The entire Department of Art faculty will make the final selection. If no qualified candidates are identified, funds will be retained for use in the next academic year.

Notification:

The Windgate Foundation Art Scholarship award winners will be notified by the end of April and are required to be present at the College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences award ceremony in May.

Materials Required for Application:

Applicants will need to supply the following materials in order to be considered for the 2010-2011 Windgate Foundation Art Scholarships in Art, Art Education, Applied Design and Art History:

- A completed 2011-2012 Windgate Foundation Scholarship application form.
- An unofficial college transcript. (BOSS transcript)
- Examples of work pertaining to degree sought.
 See below for specific requirements for Studio Art, Art

Education, Applied Design or Art History.

For an Art History applicant:

 Two typed research papers 10-15 pages (text) each. The first paper must be on an art history topic. The second should preferably be on an art history topic, but another humanities topic is acceptable. Include supplemental materials such as illustrations and bibliography. These pages are not included in the text. Submit as hard copy and on a CD.

For a Studio Art or Applied Design applicant:

- A CD PowerPoint presentation of 8-10 works. Each work
 may show more than one view or additional detail images.
 However, the number of images submitted can not be more
 than 20.
- Typed image list. The image list must list presented materials in order (be in the order of presented materials) and must include the following information: artist name, title of work, medium used, size, and date of completion.

For an Art Education applicant:

- Two typed research papers 10-15 pages (text) each. The first paper must be on an art education topic. The second should preferably be on an art history topic, but another humanities topic is acceptable. Include supplemental materials such as illustrations and bibliography. These pages are not included in the text. Submit as hard copy and on a CD.
 OR
- A CD PowerPoint presentation of 8-10 works. Each work may show more than one view or additional detail images. However, the number of images submitted can not be more than 20.
- Typed image list. The image list must list presented materials in order (be in the order of presented materials) and must include the following information: artist name, title of work, medium used, size, and date of completion.
