Housing

Housing assignments are made on a first-come, first-serve basis. Freshmen are required to live on campus in one of UIS' residence halls. Visit <u>uis.edu/housing</u> for more information about housing options, rates, and virtual tours.

Financial Assistance

We strongly encourage everyone to complete and submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon as possible after January 1st. The FAFSA is available at <u>fafsa.ed.gov</u> and is completed and submitted online. UIS' FAFSA code is 009333. To sign your FAFSA form online, students (and parents, if applicable) will need to sign up for a PIN at <u>pin.ed.gov</u>.

UIS awards merit scholarships automatically upon admission and will apply those to your account once you have started school. If you qualified for a merit award, the information is contained in your Admission Letter. Visit <u>uis.edu/financialaid</u> to apply for other scholarships.

Disability Services

Please submit your housing application with housing deposit directly to UIS Housing.

If you do not accept the offer of admission and submit the \$175 enrollment deposit by May 1, 2012 (postmark date), the offer of admission may be withdrawn. You may request a refund of the deposit in writing by May 1; the deposit is non-refundable after May 1 in all cases. If you are unable to pay the deposit, your high school guidance counselor may submit a written request for a waiver on your behalf to the Director of Admissions.
