#### Jo Daviess County 4-H Eligibility Requirements and Rules for Use of Leased Horses

• A "Leased" horse is defined as any horse that is not owned by the 4-H'er or his/her immediate family (parents, siblings, grandparents or guardians). Horses owned by distant family—aunts, uncles, or cousins—are considered leased horses.

• The **objective** of a leased horse project is to allow 4-H'ers who do not own a horse to have the opportunity to learn the skills of feeding, management, care, and training of horses. Through this experience they also learn the skills of decision-making, information gathering, communication, responsibility, and self-confidence.

• The 4-H'er agrees to make all reasonable efforts to keep the horse in safe stalls, pastures, or corrals, and to care for the horse as if he or she was the legal owner. The 4-H'er has the right to ride and exhibit this horse in all 4-H related activities.

• The 4-H'er is expected to manage and care for this horse at least from April 1 through the end of the exhibiting season (4-H Fair).

• <u>NOTE – NEW RULE: A horse may only be shown by one leasee, with the exception of family members. More than one child in the same family may lease a single horse, but the horse cannot compete against itself in any classes. NO EXCEPTIONS!</u>

#### **RISK OF LOSS**

Lessee shall immediately contact owner by telephone, and also in writing, if the horse becomes missing, lost, strayed, seriously injured, or sick or the horse dies. In case of death of the horse, the lessee assumes the cost of \$\_\_\_\_\_, while the owner assumes the loss of the horse.

#### HOLD HARMLESS

Lessee hereby agrees to hold Owner harmless for any claim resulting from damage or injury caused by the horse after commencement of this lease until the horse is returned at the end of the leasing period. Liability and accident insurance for the horse is optional by the lessee. If insurance is agreed upon, the lessee agrees to carry liability and accident insurance in the following amounts:

Upon material breach of the Agreement by one party, the other party may terminate same.
