## SEMINAR SPEAKERS

**DR. MONA BOUDREAUX** graduated from Louisiana State College of Veterinary Medicine in 1987. She is a certified veterinary acupuncturist and a certified veterinary chiropractor. Dr. Boudreaux has also studied Chinese herbal medicine in Beijing and New Mexico. She has been a member of the International Veterinary Acupuncture Society House of Delegates since 1999. She has served on the board of directors for the American Academy of Veterinary Acupuncture, and is a member of the council of elders for the American Holistic Veterinary Medical Association.

**DR. ELLEN PAUL-KUCHENBROD** graduated in 1977 from the University of Illinois College of Veterinary Medicine. She became a certified veterinary acupuncturist in 1990. She has also studied nutritional and herbal therapies since that time. She is currently the case report coordinator for the International Veterinary Acupuncture Society for acupuncture students.

**DR. DEB MITCHELL** is a 1983 graduate of the University of Illinois College of Veterinary Medicine. She also holds a Master's degree in field zoology from Southern Illinois University. She is a certified veterinary acupuncturist and certified veterinary chiropractor. Dr. Mitchell has completed training in Usui Reiki and is a fourth level Reiki master practitioner. She has also completed formal training in Traditional Chinese Medicine basic herbal training and pursues advanced training in this area. She and Dr. Boudreaux, along with Dr. Steve Marsden, serve as instructors for the Chicago Veterinary Traditional Chinese Herbal Medicine course.
