Wednesday, September 02, 2009

A meeting of the Illinois Student Senate was held on Wednesday, September 02, 2009 Central Time at the Illini Union.

## Call to Order

Bradley Tran called the meeting to order at 19:38 Central Time and welcomed the senators to the meeting. Ryan Sullivan recorded the minutes.

## **President's Report**

Bradley Tran thanked the senators for attending the UC Senate meeting and proceeded to take attendance by roll call. He announced that he has been heavily involved in talks concerning the admissions appeals process. He gave updates on other upcoming events, such as the Lunch Bunch and personal meetings that he would like to have with the senators. He then opened the floor for suggestions for potential guest speakers.

## Vice President (External)'s Report

#### ILLINOIS STUDENT SENATE Senate Resolution (09-16-2009-01)

Response to the Admissions Review Commission Report

#### BY SENATOR CAREY HAWKINS ASH AND SENATOR NOLAN DREA

WHEREAS, at present, the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign finds itself facing the challenges presented by the current admissions controversy, and

WHEREAS, the Admissions Review Commission was charged with investigating inappropriate intervention into our campus' admissions policies and procedures, and

WHEREAS, the Commission's report found that both the President of the University of Illinois and the Chancellor of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign facilitated the course of such inappropriate interventions, and

WHEREAS, the Commission's report found that the President and Chancellor were the primary executors of such intervention, this body recognizes that they did not act in isolation; that former members of the Board of Trustees as well as currently elected officials often times initiated this process, and that these persons must also bear responsibility for the damage caused to this great institution, and

WHEREAS, it was the misguided actions of a few that have caused detriment to all by subjecting the University of Illinois to unnecessary criticism and the tarnishing of its otherwise pristine reputation as a tier one research institution, and

WHEREAS, this campus' Academic Senate has expressed its sentiments on the matter, it is the responsibility of this body to proclaim and secure the best interests of the Student Body, and

WHEREAS, it must be noted that the Student Body maintains certain expectations of those who would assume the responsibility of leading and guiding this University, and

WHEREAS, holding a position of leadership at this public institution is a public trust, a seminal value that under no circumstances can be betrayed, we, the more than 41,000 duly enrolled graduate, undergraduate, and professional students of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, are unwavering in our expectations that:

The value and credibility of our degrees will be enhanced by our investment of time, talent, and tuition dollars, not diminished by those who are honor bound to protect its value,

We learn in an environment that promotes students on the basis of their academic acumen, not the influence of political prowess, and

Upon graduating, we depart the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign with the full measure of Illini pride due us through our academic pursuits, free of the pain of disappointment in our University's leadership,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Illinois Student Senate, the official voice of the Student Body at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, does hereby urge and request the Board of Trustees to act in the best interests of the Student Body, and the greater university community at large, in resolving the challenges presented by the recent admissions controversy, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that we strongly urge the Board of Trustees to consult substantively and frequently with the Illinois Student Senate as part of its decision-making process in the true spirit of shared governance, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be transmitted to the members of the Board of Trustees and the President of the University of Illinois, the Chancellor, Vice-Chancellors, Provost, and Chair of the Academic Senate of the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, the Student Body Presidents of the Universities of Illinois at Chicago and Springfield, as well as the Governor, President of the Senate, and Speaker of the House of Representatives of the state of Illinois, in addition to State Representative Naomi Jakobsson and State Senator Mike Frerichs.
