## Summer Intern Housing

### Location and Facilities

Located between Baltimore and Washington D.C., UMBC is just minutes from the Baltimore-Washington International (BWI) airport, the Baltimore Beltway (695) and Interstate 95. Summer Housing will be available in on campus apartments at UMBC.

### Availability and Cost

Summer Intern Housing is available from May 25<sup>th</sup> through August 14<sup>th</sup> and **requires a minimum six-week stay**. Interns will be charged an entire week if any portion of that week is used; weeks will run from Sunday to Saturday. **The weekly rate is \$189 per person** (linen service and cooking utensils are not provided).

### Available Campus Services

Summer interns have limited access to campus services because they are not UMBC students (who have paid student fees for these services). The following services are available to ensure that your stay is rewarding – applicable fees may apply:

- **Food Service.** Meals are available in the Campus Dining Hall or The Commons every day. Restaurants, fast food chains, grocery stores, and pizza delivery services are located close to campus. Meal plans are available by contacting Campus Card Administration at 410-455-2188;
- **Sports & Recreation.** The RAC (Retriever Activities Center) is open to the UMBC students. Other groups who will be visiting the campus may use the RAC for a fee. The RAC offers an Aquatics Center (indoor and outdoor pools), indoor and outdoor tracks, cardiovascular equipment (treadmills, ellipticals, cycles, and rowing machines), a weight room (with free weights and selectorized machines), group fitness classes, a multipurpose gymnasium, and indoor tennis. - **Transportation.** UMBC *Transit* offers transportation services to summer residents. Summer Housing Interns may use the service by paying a nominal fee. Guest passes may require confirmation of your Summer Housing and photo identification. They may be obtained at the Transportation Services Office, located in the warehouse at Poplar Avenue and Hilltop Circle (410-455-2454). UMBC *Transit* serves the Arbutus and Catonsville areas – including a number of commercial outlets that students often need – the UMB campus, and the BWI MARC/Amtrak station. - **Parking.** You will automatically be provided with a summer visitor parking pass that will allow you to park in student lots. The \$45 fee will be included in your charge. Please direct questions and concerns to Parking Services at 410-455-2551 or [parking@umbc.edu](mailto:parking@umbc.edu).
- **Internet Access.** You may request a temporary MyUMBC account during your stay by emailing [reslife@umbc.edu](mailto:reslife@umbc.edu). Please put “intern internet access request” in the subject line.

Check-in for Summer Intern Housing will begin at 12 NOON on Monday, May 25<sup>th</sup>. If your arrival date is after May 25<sup>th</sup>, please make sure that you check-in during desk hours.

To reserve your space, please complete the attached Application for Summer Intern Housing and return it to Residential Life. Applications will be accepted throughout the summer. You will then be sent and asked to sign a Summer Housing License and submit a \$200 housing deposit (check or money order) to reserve your space. The \$200 deposit is not part of your payment. **Payment in full is required upon move-in.** Please Express Mail your Summer Housing License, deposit and/or full payment so that it is received by 12 Noon the day before you intend on checking in.
