If you submit an application by February 1st, you do not need to re-apply by June 1st.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Student must be a current H.S. Senior
- 2. Student must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (on a 4.0 scale)
- 3. Student must have a minimum 25 in ACT-Math or 570 in SAT-Math (Most recent ACT SAT Math score will be considered). For alternatives to this requirement, please contact us.
- 4. Student must be interested in majoring in Engineering or Computer Science at the University of New Mexico
- 5. Although not required at the time of application for this scholarship, in order to be considered eligible to compete for a SOE scholarship, students must be admitted into UNM and the UNM-SOE by the time of the scholarship selection. As part of the scholarship pre-screening process, SOE Admissions will review all scholarship applications received. Students already in the UNM system who meet minimum requirements for admission into the UNM School of Engineering will be automatically admitted as Incoming Freshmen in the Pre-major/General Engineering Program and their scholarship applications will be forwarded to the SOES cholarship Selection Committee.

NO TE: This is not an application for UNM Admissions or UNM Scholarships. You must apply directly to them.
