CORE COURSE I: ADMINISTERING THE RETIREMENT HOUSING COMMUNITY

Focuses on the unique aspects of managing a human service organization that serves older persons. Lessons address philosophy of housing management, management and administration, human resource management, fair housing, ADA, Sec. 504, and legal issues.

CORE COURSE II: MANAGEMENT AND THE AGING RESIDENT

Concentrates on the aging process and the unique understanding professionals should have to better serve an aging population. Lessons address the aging society; biological, psychological, and social aspects of aging; long-term care and social service networks; customer service; and integrating gerontological with management principles.

CORE COURSE III: MANAGING THE FINANCIAL AND PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENTS

Addresses the skills needed to monitor the financial solvency of the retirement community as well as the physical plant. Lessons focus on the budgeting process, financial trends, environmental design, facility management, and dining services while offering a basic financial overview.
