Oh, what a difference a year makes! Last year's NESCAC tournament appearance emphasized the importance of hosting the first round of tournament play. With hard work and consistent play, the team earned the third seed in NESCAC and played host to Williams College. Beating Williams in the first round before a loud Silloway Gymnasium accomplished a goal set one year earlier. In the semi-final game of the NESCAC Championship, the team played perhaps its best basketball of the entire season, but could not sustain its effort against a bigger and deeper Tufts squad. Though the hoped-for NCAA at-large bid did not come our way, team and individual accomplishments, talented student-athletes, and a very close knit and hard working group made this season successful and satisfying. The team demonstrated determination and pride and I couldn't be prouder of their efforts.

The gymnasiums may all look different but the familiar faces that greeted us at each site brought a level of comfort and support that felt more valuable than any play in the playbook.
