

TWO CARDINAL WOMEN EXCEL DURING SUMMER COMPETITIONS

Cara Madden '11 and Janine Zaltsman '11, both of whom will be team captains in 2009-10, made the most of their opportunities during the Bay State Games in Massachusetts and the Maccabiah Games in Israel, respectively, this summer.

Cara dominated her events with four gold medals and two meet records to her credit. Capturing titles in the 100m and 200m backstroke, Cara set meet records with her times of 1:12.41 and 2:39.00, respectively. She also stroked past the competition in both the 50m and 100m freestyle, timed in :29.75 and 1:04.69, respectively.

At the Maccabiah Games, known as the Jewish Olympics and held every four years in Israel, Janine was selected to represent the United States in the women's open division. She posted the fifth-fastest trial time in the 50m free (:27.94) and the eighth-fastest trial clocking in the 100m free (1:01.89). Also competing in the 100m backstroke, Janine came through with a trial time of 1:10.48 and went on to place sixth in the finals.
