Slide Transition = Inappropriate transition style = Missing = Inappropriate type of start ("On Click" for live oral)	/ 3
Title Bar = missing = min of 2 = inappropriate = Setup in the Master Slide	/ 4
Font = Stand out against background = min of 24 pt = At least 2 differences between title and body text	/ 4
Animation = Title slide: all animation on the first click = Slide Title text: animated "after" at start of slide = Body Text: animate "on click" by item / dim except last = Images: appropriate animation & timing = Sufficient advanced animation techniques. = No Fly In Over/Under other objects (NFOU) = other:	/16

Oral Presentation

Eye Contact - Ability to hold audience's attention = looks too much at screen or monitor = reads from notes (unacceptable) = lacked good eye contact = seldom looked at the audience. (Poor or unacceptable)									
Body Language - Engages the audience / makes them feel comfortable = distracting = too rigid = fidgety = hands in pocket = hands on arm = hands on back = sway = not straight = not face audience = bob up & down = poor use of mouse									
Enthusiasm and Pace that holds the audience's attention = lacks enthusiasm = pace too slow = jerky / not smooth									
Voice - Appropriate volume, variety, and emphasis = too soft = lacks emphasis = too monotone									
Proper Professional Dress = unprofessional = too casual = shirt not tucked in = male missing tie = too much skin = too short									
Language Skills That Hold Audience's Attention = errors in grammar = distracting phrase: = overuse of "umm" = limited vocabulary = does not hold audience's attention									
Diction and Enunciation = Errors in pronunciation [] minor [] major = Audience is unable to understand phrases that were spoken									
Oral Introduction that engages the audience = missing name = missing "attention grabber" = missing title = weak attempt to engage the audience									
Oral Discussion of the Topic = lacks depth = errors = off topic = too wordy = unacceptable = read from notes									
Flow of the oral discussion made it easy for audience to follow = lacks a logical flow of the discussion = Too jerky = lacked smooth transition from point to point									
Oral Closing to the presentation - audience knows what is expected = not Q&A = not "That's It" = not "The End" = Missing "clincher"/ audience reaction = weak closing = Does not engage the audience into action = presentation must stop on the closing slide									
Preparation = _____ - did not stay within the time limit of ___ min - ___ min = do not read from paper notes
