

- There will be a \$25.00 fee for returned checks plus bank charges!
- Please **do not staple** your check to your entry form.

CREDIT CARD & FAX ENTRY SERVICE -- Please include credit cardholder's name, MasterCard/Visa number, expiration date, cardholder's signature and telephone number. EMAIL ENTRIES – You may E-Mail an entry form to the specific Trial Secretary listed for each club, using a PDF file of a scanned image of an Official AKC Entry Form with your signature. The entry form must include the Agreement attached alongside. Include credit card information; \$5.00 per dog applies for credit card entries.

- ADDITIONAL TRIAL INFORMATION -

- Rings will be matted (minimum at jumps) and enclosed with baby gates.
- All ties will be determined by run off. Any dog not present when called for the run off forfeits rights to compete
 for that prize
- <u>SPECIAL AWARD ELIGIBILITY</u> -- All exhibitors who are qualified to compete for Special Awards must fill out the enclosed form and return it with your entry. You may also turn the form in to the Trial Secretary the day of the Trial before your class begins.
- <u>MOVE-UPS</u> for obedience and rally will be allowed providing there is space available in the class and provided the Trial Secretary is notified in writing at least 30 minutes prior to judging.
- CLEAN UP IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY! If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or the rings, it is your
 responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form at this show you are agreeing that clean up is your
 responsibility. Clean up items if needed are at the check-in table or at ring-side. Exhibitors are responsible for
 policing after their animals.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From Hwy 80 East or Westbound in the Vallejo area, take the Highway 37 exit. Exit Highway 37 at Fairgrounds Drive (first exit off Highway 37). Proceed south for two blocks and turn left into Main Entrance of Fairgrounds. Bear left into fairgrounds parking lot and enter through the Main Gate. There may be a parking fee.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS - BOTH CLUBS

- 1. Telephoned, conditional, and unsigned Entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- 2. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- 3. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes received on the telephone are unacceptable.
- 4. ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
- 5. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event a dog is absent, disqualified, in season, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
- 6. A \$3.00 AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE will be required for each entry of a dog at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. A \$.50 AKC Recording Fee is required for each first entry of each dog. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). Each first entry in Rally includes a \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee and each additional Rally entry contains a \$3.00 Recording Fee, which is collected by the Show-Giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club.
- CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY AND SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the Official AKC entry form as soon as practicable. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify Trial Secretary.
- DECLINATION OF ENTRIES: The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
- DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- 10. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and/or its Trial Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
- 11. THE SHOW GIVING CLUBS, THE TRIAL SECRETARIES, their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians. The Clubs will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Vallejo Dog Training Club and the Napa Valley Dog Training Club will not be responsible for loss.
- NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW AREA except those regularly entered in the show. There will be NO SPACE for unentered dogs at this show. ALL DOGS shall be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
- 13. ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Trial Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The show-giving club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.
- 14. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.



AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. - (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, Wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed.
